5. Applicant will be limited to enrolling in up to three (3) courses in a calendar year with a maximum award of \$300.00.
6. The recipient will have the option of enrolling at the institution of their choice.
7. If the application is not completed properly, it will be eliminated. Please take time to fill in all information completely.
